



GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

SCIO is pleased to offer Alumni Scholarships funded by a generous gift from Geoffrey and Caroline de Jager. Applicants must be alumni of its student programmes (SSO and OSP). Up to three scholarships of £2,500 each will be awarded to alumni registered for a graduate degree at the University of Oxford.

Particulars

- The scholarships are available for students who are alumni of SSO or OSP and who will be registered for a graduate degree programme at the University of Oxford for the period for which they will hold the scholarship
- The scholarships will be awarded based on academic merit, academic potential, and vision for a scholarly vocation
- The scholarships may be renewable for a second and final year

One scholarship is offered in each of the following areas:

1. Texts and manuscripts with a focus on New Testament studies
2. Science and religion
3. Subjects in, or broadly related to, SCIO's teaching fields (see SCIO's list of subjects at <https://www.bestsemester.com/locations-and-programs/oxford/sso/academics/tutorials>)

Application process

Applicants should send to scio.admin@wycliffe.ox.ac.uk

- a CV
- an outline of the research they hope to do in Oxford (500 words)
- proof of their having been accepted on a University of Oxford graduate course

Applicants should also arrange for two confidential letters of support to be sent to scio.admin@wycliffe.ox.ac.uk. For applicants not already studying in Oxford one recommendation must be from a tutor with whom the student studied in Oxford for SSO or OSP. For applicants who are already graduate students at Oxford, one recommendation must be from their Oxford supervisor. Dr Rosenberg and Dr Baigent cannot write recommendations since they are on the election committee.

There is no deadline. Applications are welcome at any time.
